Winemaking Description: Following in the tradition, the Indra Block delivers another wine of exceptional quality. Made from very low yields in 100% new French oak with minimal intervention.

Review: "Intensely meaty, intensely spicy, intensely concentrated shiraz. Seductive, and then some. Silken texture, awash with blueberries, blackberries and black cherried fruit, inlaid with five-spice, cactus and assorted dried herbs, and sunk through with classy oak. Spicy, fruit-soaked tannin oozes from the back of the mid-palate onwards. It's an outstanding wine." **96 points, Campbell Mattinson, The Wine Front**
