



## The story of the wine ...

## 2018 Lethbridge Pinot Noir

Winemaking: Sourced from four single vineyards in Geelong, two in the Moorabool Valley (Hillside Haven & Springbank) and two from the Bellarine (Hat Rock & Suma Park)

All fruit was handpicked and fermented separately to keep the individual vineyard characters distinct.

Each parcel was treated the same; wild yeast fermented with around 40% whole bunches. The wine was then matured for 10 months in 40% new French oak barriques. After rigorous tastings we blended the wines to create this wonderful Pinot Noir in the Lethbridge style.

Tasting Note: Dark plums and spice abound on the nose, the 2018 Pinot Noir is savoury and spicy on the palate. This is a wine of finesse with dense red and black cherries and complex tannins.
