2021 Ooh La La Chardonnay

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The Ooh La La is made in large format French barrels partially new and partially old so that we have a subtle influence of oak marrying beautiful with citrus line of the fruit

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Ooh La La is made in the "house" style, vivacious and voluptuous but subtle.

Winemaking Description: The cool summer produced grapes with high and refreshing levels of acidity. Free run juice was used and then barrel fermented using wild yeast. Lees stirring added texture and complexity during 7 months in old and new French oak.

Tasting Notes: A beautifully clean, pure nose of ripe melon, lemon zest, white peach with a lick of vanilla and toast from the oak. This has texture balanced with a mouth-watering acidity giving a classic, elegant style of Chardonnay to suit all occasions.
