Vineyard: Barrett’s Vineyard, Portland

Alcohol: 11.5% alc/vol.

Cellar potential: 1-2 years, or drink after 7 years

Germanic in Style

- Fruit sourced from vines planted in 1982 at Barrett’s Vineyards near Drumborg.
- Traditional German winemaking techniques.
- Handpicked grapes were whole bunch pressed into tank for fermentation by wild yeast on partial solids.
- Fermentation stopped to leave 10g/L residual sugar.
- Brilliant pale straw colour.
- Crisp and balanced wine, rich in citrus fruit flavours - lime, orange blossom and mandarin followed by hints of musk.
- The off-dry, palate is complemented by fresh acidity, and finishes cleanly with lingering aromatics of lime and musk.
