## 2010 Indra Shiraz

Winemaking Description: Following in the tradition, the Indra Block delivers another wine of exceptional quality. Made from very low yields in 100% new French oak with minimal intervention.

Tasting Notes: The wine exhibits a perfumed nose of violets, dark plum, liquorice, graphite followed by wood spice. The wine is Northern Rhône in style, with spicy notes complemented by red berry, sour plum and dark cherry. A powerfully structured wine with fine grained tannins, excellent length and persistence but will need 5 years before it starts to drink at its peak.
