2017 Lethbridge Single Vineyard Pinot Noir Suma Park Vineyard, Bellarine Peninsula

Suma Park is beautifully situated on the limestone outcrop of Marcus Hill, overlooking Swan Bay. It is the pride and passion of Barry Proven who, surprisingly for an accountant, really 'gets' that some things in life are not about money. The grapes are grown on shallow red clay over limestone and the wines always show the influence of the sea. The salty air and chalky soils produce a Pinot Noir that is bright and crunchy with lifted aromatics and fine We have made delicious Pinot Noir with Barrie's grapes for many years, but this is our first single vineyard 'Suma'.

The Vineyard: Planted in 1999 the vineyard is loam over clay with some buckshot above a significant limestone base. The Pinot Noir has an almost saline aroma that gives the wine a moreish quality.
