2019 Amber Wine

About B5B: Between Five Bells are the last three words in the first stanza of Kenneth Slessor's famous poem, Five Bells. The poem is understood to tell the tale of the death of Joe Lynch, a friend of the poets, and is set on/in/around (it gets confusing) Sydney Harbour. A beautiful lyrical poem, well worth a read and central to the way we think about the B5B wines.

The Wine: For no other reason than to be delicious. This is the THIRD release of our AMBER wine. When it should be drunk is up to you, probably not long after it comes into your possession.

Made with Pinot Gris which spent 45 days on skins, Greco was added which spent 60 days on skins, Fiano a few days later (had spent 40 days on skins), & Riesling came later which had spent 18 days on skins. The resulting wine has a tannic quality about it, vibrant ginger and spiced candied orange peel and a delicious viscous finish.
