2020 Suma Park Pinot Noir Single Vineyard

The Story: Suma Park is beautifully situated on the limestone outcrop of Marcus Hill, overlooking Swan Bay. It is the pride and passion of Barry Proven who, surprisingly for an accountant, really 'gets' that some things in life are not about money. The grapes are grown on shallow red clay over limestone and the wines always show the influence of the sea.

The salty air and chalky soils produce a Pinot Noir that is bright and crunchy with lifted aromatics and fine tannins. We havbe made a delicious Pinot Noir with barry's grapes for many years. Enjoy!

The Wine: Made in the signature Lethbridge style, an indigenous ferment with 50% whole bunch is followed by barrel aging in 50% new French oak. Intensely fragrant with cranberry, red cherries, raspberry and dried goji berry. Savoury earth and a hint of stalk. Immense complexity and great concentration of fruit. This wine is drinking beautifully now or will benefit from time in the cellar.
