The Story: Aglianico (pronounced 'ahl-YAH-nee-koe', from the word Hellenic) is a noble red grape brought to the south of Italy by the greeks during their widespread expansion around 700BC. This lasting Hellenic imprint that would inspire the culture of ancient Rome also inspired me to make something that is both mysterious and alluring.

Aglianico is a grape variety that caught my imagination from early in my life as a winemaker. I was intrigued that good examples of wines made from this grape could play with the juxtaposition of intensity and finesse. I hope you enjoy my contemplations."

The Wine: Fermented in our Tuscan clay amphora, left on skins for 27 days, pressed and racked off back into a mixture of amphora and new barriques for aging. This a fabulous expression of the variety showing dark dried plums, black tea with a splendid tannin structure with plenty of potential for aging.
