2024 Estate Riesling

The Story: Riesling is finally experiencing a well deserved resurgence in popularity among wine lovers. The plethora of styles available, combined with its ability to be paired with a variety of foods should make Riesling a go to wine. At Lethbridge, we have been working with this Noble variety for nearly two decades and in this time experimented with many styles, from dry to sweet, sparkling to amber. This Riesling follows one of our well travelled roads.

The Wine: From our friend Barrie Provins cool climate 'Barwite' vineyard in the King Valley. The fruit was partially whole bunch pressed and wild fermented in small batches in both large format oak and stainless steel. Aged on lees to increase complexity before bottling.

The result is a delightfully floral nose with a bitey lick of lemon curd. The lively acidity and minerality are balanced with 13g/L of residual sugar creating a beautifully round and long-lasting finish.
