2024 Stephanie Rosé



The Story: As winemakers we love to see a wine mature with time and while Rosé is not really a wine that delivers great thing with time, the namesake of this wine, Stephanie, most certainly has done. From cartwheels to coding, watching Stephanie mature from the child Indra brought home from school at the age of 5 to a mature and wonderful woman has been a joy. As with our wines, we look forward to what the future holds for her and being part of her journey. This Rosé named in her honour is made from 51% Nebbiolo, 49% Pinot Noir, indigenous yeast fermented and barrel aged. Sophisticated and complex, just like its name sake.

The Wine: This year the 'Stephanie' Rose is made from Nebbiolo and Pinot Noir. Made in a textural, complex style, whole bunches were gently pressed to extract a splash of colour and retain delicate aromas. The juice was fermented long and cool by indigenous yeast in older oak. The wine was then aged on fine lees in large format old oak. The resulting wine is vibrant and sophisticated, with aromas of Summer strawberries and blood orange, finishes long and dry.
